LOCATION

Phuket

Phuket is the largest island in Thailand located in the sparkling emerald waters of the Andaman sea. Embark in the *Yacht Haven Marina* located a 15minute drive from *Phuket International airport* and cruise to *Phang Nga national park*.

With over 100 islands and islets and impressive sheer limestone karsts, it offers breathtaking scenery, exciting exploration, secret coves and the signature rocky pinnacle of *James Bond Island*. Indulge yourself in the exquisite fresh fish prepared by the onboard Chef and admire the views from Lamima as the sun sets.





LOCATION

Koh Phi Phi

Among the most enchanting islands of Thailand, the two *Phi Phi* islands offer spectacular vertical cliffs rising from the sparkling sea like fortresses, beautiful lagoons and idyllic tropical beaches. *Phi Phi Le*, the southernmost of the islands, offers the picturesque lagoon made famous by *The Beach* starring Leonard DiCaprio.

Enjoy Lamima's watersports or go diving - the spectacular limestone cliffs above the water become sheer drop-offs and coral gardens underwater with a rich and colourful diversity of marine life. Even whale sharks have been sighted here.



LOCATION

Racha Noi

The island of *Racha Noi* (Little King Island) offers truly spectacular dive and snorkeling sites with a great chance to see reef sharks, manta rays or whale sharks.

The underwater landscape is reminiscent of the Similan Islands with giant boulders covered with large soft corals, powder white sandy bays and exceptional visibility. Enjoy a fresh cocktail back onboard during the sunset cruise.





LOCATION

Koh Lanta

A 25km long island south of *Krabi*, renowned for its secluded endless beaches, natural beauty above and below the water and legendary sunsets. The dive sites surrounding *Koh Lanta* are considered to be some of Thailand's finest with reefs teeming with vibrant sea life.

Step ashore and wander through the beautiful gardens of 5* *Pimalai Resort* before dining in the restaurant which harvests its vegetables from its own organic farm.



LOCATION

Similan Islands

Heading North West of Phuket, these nine uninhabited tropical islands are renowned for their pure white coral beaches, huge granite boulders, colourful coral reefs and incredibly diverse marine life making this archipelago one of the most popular dive locations in the world.

Swim with turtles and marvel at the spectacular underwater beauty, take a romantic stroll along a deserted beach or relax and soak up the natural beauty of this destination.





LOCATION

Surin Islands

The *Surin Islands* coral reefs excellent for snorkeling and the world famous dive site of *Richelieu Rock*. Visit a traditional village of Moken – sea gypsies that live on *Kob Surin Tai* – who derive everything they need from the sea.

Look out for their *kabang* traditional boats crafted from a single piece of wood from which they live and work. Enjoy dinner onboard prepared with fresh fish caught that day.



LOCATION

Mergui Archipelago

With over 800 islands to choose from, the *Mergui Archipelago* located in the southernmost part of *Myanmar (Burma)* has something for guests of all ages.

Tropical rainforests for exploration and bird watching, pristine sandy beaches for young children, extensive coral reefs for snorkeling and diving and even a five star casino club golf resort on Thahtay Island. The remote location means that much of the archipelago has not yet been thoroughly explored and the nomadic Moken can often be seen fishing or diving for pearls.
